B: She'll have to buy some new clothes before she goes.

B: Because she doesn't like the old clothes she's got.

A: She'll have to learn the words of the song before she goes.

B: Why will she have to do that?

A: Because she doesn't know all the words of the song.

B: She'll have to buy a book about Switzerland before she goes.

A: Why will she have to do that?

B: Because she doesn't know anything about Switzerland.
